## General Golf Information

Play is governed by the Rules of Golf and Etiquette of the United States Golf Association, and as amended by any Local Rules.

**All members and guests are required to check-in with the Pro Shop and sign in their guest prior to beginning play.**

**Tee times** can be made one week in advance.

Each player must have his or her **own equipment**.

**Slow play**, which results in holding up other golfers, will not be tolerated. Players must maintain pace with other golfers or lose their position on the course. Therefore, players are expected to maintain pace of play throughout their round of golf. If there is an open hole in front of your group, you must allow faster players to play through regardless of the number of players in the group.

On Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays during the months of April through October, **no five-some** will be permitted to tee off between the hours of 8:00AM and 12:00 PM.

**No player may start on any hole other than No. 1** unless permitted to do so by the Golf Professional or his staff. Golfers who finish the 9th hole, and do not tee off No. 10 as soon as the hole is open, forfeit their position and must not restart if they impair approaching golfers in any way.

## Dress Code

The following dress code is mandatory for all players. Improperly dressed golfers will be asked to change before playing or practicing. If you are in doubt concerning your attire, please call the Pro Shop before starting play.

### **Gentleman:**

Acceptable: Shirts with collars and sleeves, slacks and golf shorts up to four inches above the knee are considered appropriate attire.

Not Acceptable: Tank tops, tee shirts, fishnet tops, cut-offs, overalls, jams, sweatpants, tennis shorts or other athletic shorts more than four inches above the knee are not permitted.

### **Ladies:**

Acceptable: Dresses, skirts, slacks, golf shorts up to six inches above the knee, golf shirts, and blouses are considered appropriate attire.

Not Acceptable: Halter tops, tank tops, fishnet tops, cut-offs, bathing suits, sweatpants, short shorts, tennis skirts or athletic shorts are not permitted.

**Dress jeans in good taste are permitted for both Gentlemen and ladies only during the winter months while we are on Eastern Standard Time. Jeans are not permitted during the months we are Daylight Savings Time.**

# EAST TENNESSEE GOLF ASSOCIATION 2008

## SENIOR GOLF ASSOCIATION

The ETSGA is an organization of 16 East Tennessee country clubs ranging from Fairfield Glade in the West to Link Hills in the East. In between are Willow Creek, Springbrook, Morristown, Woodlake, Smoky Mountain, Clinch View, Oak Ridge, Patriot Hills, Lost Creek, Beaver Brook, Baneberry, Tellico, Millstone, Royal Oaks, and Green Meadow. Members get to play each course one time in tournaments scheduled from April thru September. Tournaments are individual play flighted by handicap, 20 to 24 players in a flight, with three gross score and three net score winners per flight. There are no greens fees. A three day tournament is held in the last week in September. Spouses are invited, and activities are arranged for non-golfing spouses. Membership cost is \$30 plus a cost of \$7 for each tournament you choose to enter. ETSGA members join the Friday Seniors in the **free kick-off breakfast** noted above. A member must be at least 60 years of age sometime during the current year. Call Ted Williams, (681-0675) for additional details. New players of any skill level are welcome.

## SENIOR GOLF 2008

### FRIDAY SENIOR TOURNAMENTS

A Senior Tournament is held every Friday at either 8:30 or 9:00 a.m. beginning in mid March through the first Friday in November. There is no minimum age requirement. The cost to join the Friday Seniors is \$10 and the cost to enter each tournament is \$4. All fees come back as prizes. All tournaments are flighted by handicap (which range from 2 to 30) and only net scores are used to determine winners. A tournament on any Friday may be individual, 2-man team, or 4-man team play. Participants sign up in the Pro Shop or call in on the answering machine no later than 7:00 a.m. Friday. There are **two free breakfasts**: one to kick-off the season and one to end it. See Earl Morgan, 982-8165, for additional details. New players of any skill level are welcomed.

### TOM CLARK OPEN.

The Tom Clark Open is an informal tournament open to anyone who doesn't mind being referred to as a "senior". This is a year round tournament (yes right through the winter) with a 10:00 a.m. tee time. You don't have to get a tee time, round up a foursome, or sign up—just show up at least 20 minutes before tee time. Players put a dollar in the pot, then make up teams from the folks who are there for some type of team game. The group functions every Monday and Wednesday year round, and on every Friday November thru March (when the Friday Seniors are not playing).
